1. Comprehensive outlines on the 14 topics noted in the table of contents. The outlines consist of objectives, thorough subject related content, case examples, comprehensive reference listings by topic and self-assessment questions and answers. These are provided to you in a book sent via mail and online.
2. Online access to the speakers' presentation of content consisting of PowerPoint presentations synced with the audio presentations. Presentations are not intended to review the outline material but offer application of content through case studies. For that reason, it is recommended that you thoroughly review the comprehensive outlines prior to viewing the online presentations.
3. Up to twenty hours of ACPE credit upon successful completion of the required online examinations.

Accessing the Course

Each module is available online at cpnp.org and consists of a detailed outline complete with thorough content, self-assessment questions and references. Speaker presentations on the topic areas are also available and are designed to allow for application of the concepts presented in the detailed outline for each topic.

1. The first time you log into cpnp.org, go to the password box in the upper right corner of the home page and click on password help. Enter your email address as prompted and as provided to CPNP. Within 30 seconds, an email will be sent to that email address containing a password consisting of random numbers and letters. Copy the password, return to cpnp.org and log in using the email (user name) and password. Once you are logged in, you can change the password to something more memorable again using the password help link.
2. Once logged in, you can access all Review Course presentations, examinations and evaluations at [My CPNP](#) or at the [course web pages](#). You may find it convenient to bookmark this course page.
3. Each of the 14 presentations is accessible to you as individual modules with individual examinations. You can complete in any order you wish and as many as you want. Once you [select a module](#), you are directed to an individual page for that module which provides access to the speaker presentation, the examination and additional reference information on the module.

4. It is suggested that you review the detailed outline for each module in the book first followed by the speaker presentation of the content. The speaker presentations are designed to supplement the outline content by offering brief instruction followed by case study implementation. Examination questions (8 per module) are drawn from the module rather than the presentation.
5. When you have studied the outline and presentation for a module, you will be ready to complete the module examination followed immediately by an evaluation for that module. Passing has been established at 60% or above for each module.
6. Once you have successfully completed a module, you will be linked to the CPNP ACPE statement of credit center. However, credits will accumulate so it may be more efficient to print your statement of credit after you complete the last module.

Successfully Completing the Course

To receive ACPE credit, an examination for each topic must be completed as verification that the material has been studied and mastered. The Review Course examinations consist of multiple-choice questions. The cut-off/passing score for each examination is 60%. The exams can only be completed [online](#) at each module page. The 2012-2013 APNA Endorsed CPNP Psychiatric Pharmacotherapy Review Course examinations were released January 18, 2012 and will expire December 31, 2013 at midnight central time.

Partial credit is available for individual topics within the Review Course; if you successfully complete all 14 examinations, you will receive 20 total hours of ACPE credit.
